Established in 1992 by two former teachers, Stone Farm Study Centre is located on the edge of Dartmoor in the heart of the Devon countryside. Set in the foothills of the National Park, the site boasts 110 acres of organic park-land pasture and is an idyllic retreat for children to visit.

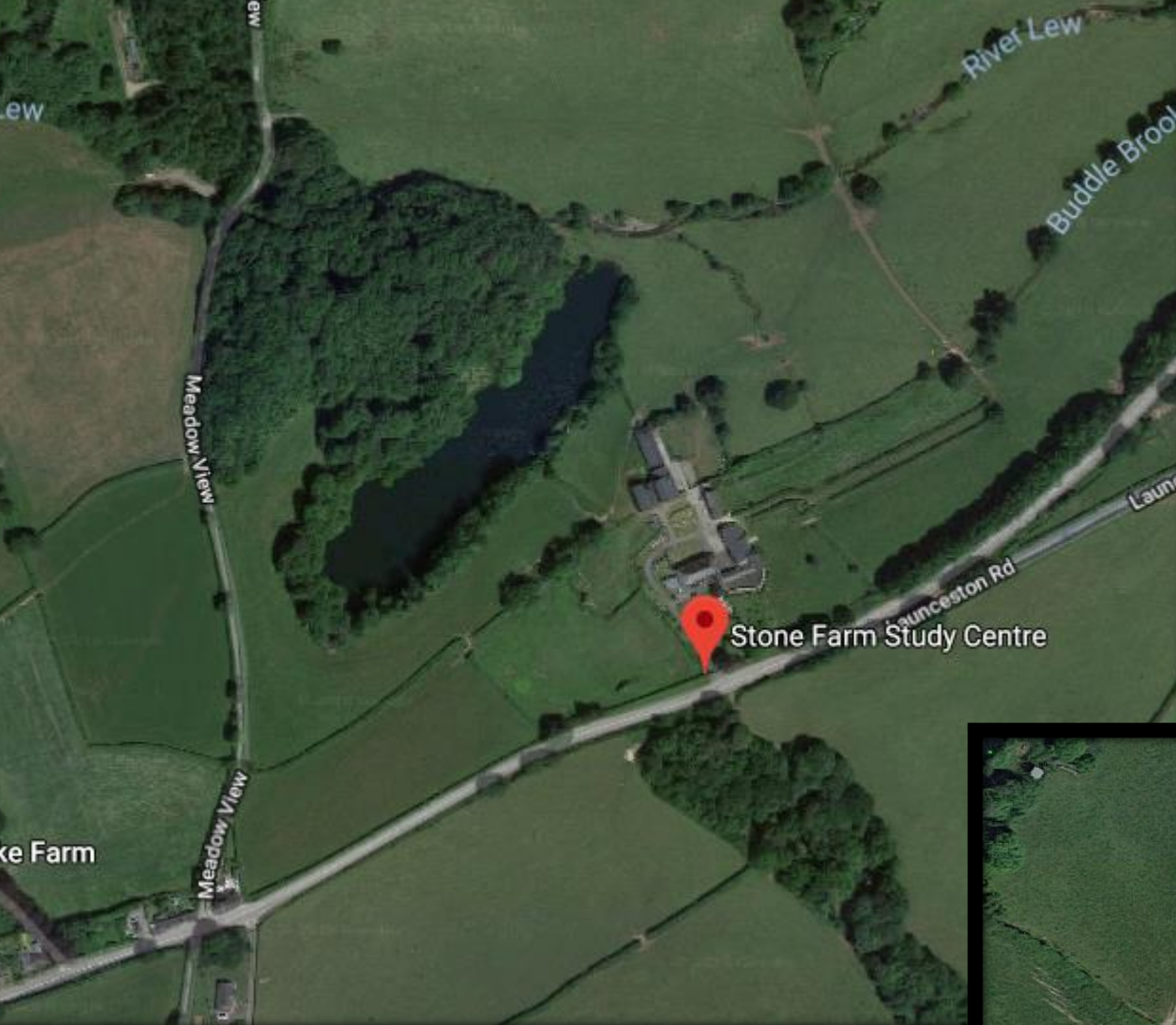
Among 17th century listed buildings we have a traditional working farm where every morning and evening visiting groups can help with supervised farm jobs - complete with pigs, sheep, rabbits, guinea pigs, goats, alpacas, a donkey, a pony, 'Hedwig' the African eagle owl and resident sheepdog Diesel there really is something for everyone! Stone Farm also has its own onsite lake where, if lucky, the children will be able to spot local birdlife including ducks, geese, moorhen and kingfishers and when taking a nature walk in the adjoining woodland we often see deer, foxes and badgers.

A traditional farm house with dining area, living space, dormitories, kitchen, toilet and showers.



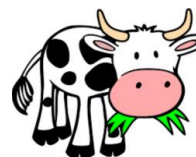

Kit List essentials

We will be living on a working farm for the week so please make sure that all clothing is **PRACTICAL** rather than **FASHIONABLE**.

Please **mark all items clearly with your child's name**, including footwear (both feet).

All items should be packed into a sports bag or small suitcase clearly labelled.

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- A practical rucksack for day trips,
- Water bottle to refill each day,
- **Lunch for day one in a disposable bag,**
- 2 carrier bags: one for dirty washing and one wet clothes after water sports.
- Plastic bag/bin bag in rucksack to sit on during lunchtimes.
- £9 for Stone Farm T-shirt in a named envelope (optional- this needs to be cash handed in at check-in)
- Torch (optional).

Footwear

- **Wellington boots** (essential) with long socks e.g. football socks (for farm duties),
- Comfortable, practical shoes x2 (trainers),
- Shoes for barn dance (It is a barn so uneven flooring- these still need to be practical.)
- Slippers/indoor shoes (e.g. sliders).

Clothing

- Waterproof coat (essential),
- Warm layers (hoodies, fleeces, jumpers),
- T-shirts (enough for the week with spare),
- Trousers: leggings/ tracksuit bottoms/ pair of shorts,
- One set of old clothes to be used for farm jobs only (please put in a plastic bag in the suitcase),
- Barn dance/disco outfit e.g. checked shirt and jeans,
- Nightwear: warm pyjamas, onesie, dressing gown,

- Sufficient underwear and socks (including spare pairs),
- Long socks for wellies,
- Towel (for showering)

Toiletries

- Toothbrush and toothpaste,
- Sun cream and sun hat/warm hat,
- Lip balm (essential),
- Deodorant (must be roll on. No aerosols or glass bottles),
- Shampoo, conditioner and shower gel.

Bedding *(to be packed in a labelled bin bag)*

- Sleeping bag or duvet with cover,
- Pillowcase,
- Own pillow (optional as a pillow is provided).

No additional money is needed.

Entertainment

- Teddy – needed for room inspections,
- Reading book,
- Note book, puzzle book, colouring pencils and/or playing cards for journey.

ELECTRONICS TO BE LEFT AT HOME:

no mobile phones, electronic games or Ipods/mp3s/I-watches.

Camera: disposable or digital only (children will be responsible for their own cameras).
