Brass Day at Mountbatten School

Last Sunday, a group of pupils who have been learning brass instruments in school attended a 'Brass Day' at The Mountbatten School with Mrs Daas and Miss Hall. The day was organised and funded by Hampshire Music Service, Romsey Rotary Club and run in partnership with schools from across the area – this meant a total of approximately 80 pupils spent the day learning and playing their brass instruments. The day began by meeting the professional musicians who were leading the day, which included musicians who play as part of the BBC Concert Orchestra for Wales (recording the Doctor Who theme song) and a current member of the orchestra in The Lion King on the West End in London. Most notably, we were joined by Carol Jarvis, a professional musician who has performed and recorded with stars such as Taylor Swift, Queen, Sting and many more! We then spent the day rehearsing performance pieces that we shared with a packed audience of parents at the end of the day. Our pupils rose to the challenge of reading complex musical notation, some of which they had never seen before!



All of our pupils were a credit to North Baddesley Junior School and Mrs Daas and Miss Hall were so pleased to see all the children engaging with this opportunity – even Mrs Daas decided to join in! Please keep an eye out for any further musical opportunities that may arise through our connections with Hampshire Music Service and The Mountbatten School. Our ensemble is due to play in the playground for our playground prom at 3:10 on Wednesday 8th May outside the Resources Room. We are looking forward to hearing them play.
