Suggested Kit List for Avon Tyrrell



- Towel
- Wash kit (travel sized soap, toothpaste and toothbrush, roll on deodorant – if wanted, hair ties)
- Named water bottle (spare one if you have one)
- Torch
- Plastic bag for laundry/wet clothes
- Pyjamas
- Warm fleeces/jumpers
- Warm hat (if cold)
- Sun hat (if warm)
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- Change of clothes for each day (long sleeves and long trousers – not jeans)
- Small rucksack for the day
- Slippers for inside
- Sun lotion (if warm)
- Outdoor shoes (more than one pair- get muddy during activities)
- One teddy
- Reading book
- Wet activity clothes (old clothes, old trainers/wet shoes)

No electrical equipment

No sweets or snacks in luggage

No aerosols

During physical activities earrings are not to be worn. Children must be able to remove these independently – if not, please ensure children do not have these in during the trip.

**No sprays!
Roll on only.**

**No food / sweets
in suitcases!**

Must be in a labelled holdall / suitcase that they can carry up stairs. A bag per day within the suitcase is a good idea!

Medication

All medication needs to be handed in to school office in advance with the completed medical form on Tuesday 17th March between 8:30 - 9:00.

(There are medical forms at the back of the room. You will need to complete one form per item of medication. There are separate forms for inhalers.)

It must be in its proper prescribed packaging.

If it is not prescribed medication, it must still be in its packaging.

Travel sickness tablets for the return journey must also be handed in, in advance in their original packaging.



Medication cont:



Asthmatic children:

(Separate medical form.)

Inhalers need to be handed in along with all other medication on Tuesday 17th March.

If your child still needs this inhaler at home, this will need to be handed in to a member of staff the morning of the trip.

Please do not put it in their bag.

On the medical form, you chose whether to give signed permission for Calpol to be administered if required. This will enable us to deal with minor illnesses effectively without curtailing your child's stay.



Sleeping

You will be given the opportunity to tell us about any issues that may effect your child's ability to sleep at Avon Tyrrell.

These can include:

- Bed wetting
- Night terrors
- Sleep walking



Staff have experience of helping children with sleep issues on residential trips and we are better able to help your child if we are fully informed.
