Welcome Back to School

Attendance, Absences and Safeguarding

It is extremely important that your child has the best possible attendance. School for the children starts on Tuesday 1st September and doors will be opened at 8.40. Registration takes place at 8.50. Prefects will close the doors at 8.50. Any child that arrives after 8.50 will need to go through reception and will be marked in the register as late. Please note that regular lateness can trigger a fine or referral.

If your child is absent, please let the office know via a phone call (message can be left on the absence line) or through parent mail. Please can we kindly request that you do not email the school office account regarding

absences. The office/home support worker will contact you if you have not already informed us as to why your child is not in school – this is standard procedure. For absences to be authorised for appointments (e.g., dentist, doctors) then we will need you to provide evidence confirming this to ensure that the correct code is assigned to the absence.

Holidays will not be authorised; however, a leave of absence form must be filled in and submitted before you take your child outside of school during term time; this ensures transparency and gives the school time to inform parents of the attendance policies and procedures. Holiday forms can be collected from the school office or downloaded off the website. Parents that are thinking about taking their child out of school for a period of time are advised to read the updated guidance and [information on penalty](#)

notices for non-attendance at school.

We ask parents to provide honest reasons for absences to support open communication and foster positive relationships.

Safeguarding Reminder

There is **no access between the Junior and Infant School playgrounds before 8:40am**. Gates will be open from 8:40am to 9:00am and again from 3:10pm to 3:30pm. After 3:30pm, playground gates will be locked to safeguard children who remain on site.

Ordering Lunches

At the junior school children have the option of bringing in their own packed lunch or ordering a school dinner from one of three daily choices. Children will continue to order their lunches via their class teacher each morning. The menu is displayed in every classroom - the class teacher will happily guide the children. Please read through

the [daily menu](#) with your child at home. Unlike the infant phase, all dinners have to be paid for. The cost of a school dinner is currently £2.75. Please ensure that you have registered your child if you believe you are entitled to [free school meals](#). If you are entitled to free school meals but you have not registered then you will need to pay for your child's school dinner. We are happy to assist you in registering, if required.

Tuck Shop

The tuck shop will continue to be open at break times. Items range from 20p to a £1. The tuck shop is cash operated by Chartwells and the staff monitor the children's choices.



Payments

We prefer for parents to pay for school dinners and trips online; however, cash or

cheques are accepted in a named envelope. If you encounter issues paying online or setting up your account, please speak to the school office who will always be happy to help.

Autumn Term Clubs

Details of our Autumn Term clubs are attached to this newsletter. Registration for school-led clubs took place during the Summer Term and confirmation of places will be sent out shortly.

Some external clubs, such as Gym, Football, Dance, Karate, and Tennis are managed directly by the providers. You can contact them directly to see if there are any available spaces - there are spaces left in most of the outsider provider clubs.

Thank you for your understanding, and we look forward to another exciting term of extracurricular opportunities for our pupils.

Medicines.

Please can we remind parents that all medications e.g. inhalers, auto injectors, antihistamine etc... must be handed into reception with [the relevant paperwork](#) on the first day of term.

Library

Children have weekly access to the school library. Children can take out two books at a time. Our librarian (Mrs Parkes) will open up the library on Tuesday after school until 4pm for parents to come and choose books with their children. I encourage parents to use this facility, as our librarian is always happy to help guide children in their choice of books. Mrs Parkes will also try to hire in books that children would love to read.

Having replaced a lot of lost books this summer, we will unfortunately have to charge for lost and damaged books. We will discuss with the children the importance of

looking after library books in class and through our weekly assemblies. If you ever have any queries about a book, please ask to speak to our librarian who will always be happy to help.

Jewellery and school

uniform

Our [school uniform statement of practice](#) can be found on our school website. Please can we remind parents that trainers are not permitted as school shoes and school shoes must be all black. In addition, the only jewellery permitted to be worn is stud earrings and a watch. All jewellery should be removed for any physical activities including PE/games lessons; specifically, earrings must be removed (not covered with tape) to avoid risk of accident and injury. As such, parents are asked to consider the timings of any new piercings carefully in relation to the time required for safe removal. Lessons may have to be adapted if

your child cannot take out their earrings.

Smart Watches/devices

For safeguarding reasons, smart watches that can take photos, record and make phone calls are not permitted to be worn during the school day. Watches that tell the time and/or only have the capacity to monitor fitness and steps are permitted.

Walking independently to and from school

We want to keep you informed about our collection procedures for pupils in Years 3 to 6 at our school. For parents of children in Years 3 and 4, we kindly ask that a trusted adult is present for the collection of your child at the end of the school day.

For parents of children in Years 5 and 6, if you prefer your child to walk home independently, you must have completed the waiver on Arbor. This waiver is a

blanket agreement, meaning that by signing it, you are giving your consent for your child to walk home on their own daily. The school will not permit children to walk home independently on specific days unless the waiver has been signed. If you have signed the waiver but would still prefer your child to wait at the school gates, please ensure your child understands this arrangement and is aware of your wishes.

We appreciate your cooperation and support in ensuring the safety and well-being of all our pupils.

Daily Active Mile

All children will continue to take part in the Daily Active Mile, supporting healthy and active lifestyles. Children choose to walk, jog or run. It is an opportunity for the entire school to participate and be together.

If your child is unable to participate in physical activity, please provide a note to the school.

Values Assemblies

We are delighted to continue welcoming parents and carers to our Values Assemblies on Friday mornings to celebrate pupils' achievements and recognise their hard work. They begin at 9:00 and last approximately 30 minutes. If your child has been selected to receive an award, you will be notified via ParentMail a week in advance. Due to the capacity of our school hall and the number of families invited each week, we are unfortunately unable to change or swap a child's allocated assembly date. We appreciate your understanding and support in helping us ensure that all families have a fair opportunity to attend.

Phones. To help maintain a safe, respectful and child-focused environment, we ask all parents and visitors to put their mobile phones away whilst on the school site, including in the playground. We appreciate your support in modelling positive behaviour and helping us keep our school community focused on learning and wellbeing.

Children should **not bring smart devices onto school premises.** This includes smartphones, smartwatches with communication capabilities and any other internet-enabled devices.

If a child requires a phone for travel to and from school, a **basic mobile phone**

("brick phone") may be brought to school, provided that a Mobile Phone Waiver Agreement has been signed by both the parent/carer and the child. Please note that this is a new agreement and any previously signed waivers are no longer valid.

These phones must be placed in a **named, clear sandwich bag** and handed in to the school office at the start of the school day. Staff will ensure that they are handed back before the end of the school day. Thank you for your cooperation in helping us create a safe, secure and distraction-free environment for all pupils.

Roadworks.

Rownhams Road Carriageway Repairs Hampshire County Council has advised that essential carriageway repair works will take place on Rownhams Road, North Baddesley, from **14 September 2026** for approximately **8 days**.

During the works, Rownhams Road will be **closed to through traffic between 9:30am and 4:00pm daily**. Access arrangements may vary depending on progress, and any significant changes to the schedule will be communicated on-site via yellow roadwork signs.

Residents are asked not to park on the road during the works period to help ensure the repairs can be completed safely and efficiently. Vehicles obstructing the works may be removed. Properties close to the works area may experience some temporary disruption while the repairs are carried out.

OUR AIMS

- ✓ Promote safe and responsible phone/electronic use

KEY POINTS

1 STAFF USE



- Do not use personal mobile phones while children are present / during contact time.
- Use only in non-contact time and in areas where pupils are not present (e.g. staffroom).
- No use to process, store or share personal or confidential data.

2 PUPIL USE



- Not allowed to use phones or smartwatches during the school day.
- Phones must be switched off and handed in at the office each morning and collected at the end of the day.
- Only in exceptional circumstances with school permission.

3 PARENTS, VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS



- Do not use mobile phones on school site where children are present.
- Use phones only in designated areas.
- Follow the school's instructions at all times.

4 WHY WE HAVE THIS POLICY



- Protect child safety
- Protect personal data
- Prevent lesson disruption
- Reduce risk of theft, loss or damage
- Promote appropriate use of technology

5 LOSS, THEFT OR DAMAGE



The school is not liable for lost, stolen or damaged phones. Please keep devices safe and clearly labeled.

6 BREACHES



Breaches of this policy may result in sanctions in line with our behaviour policy. Repeated breaches may lead to further action.

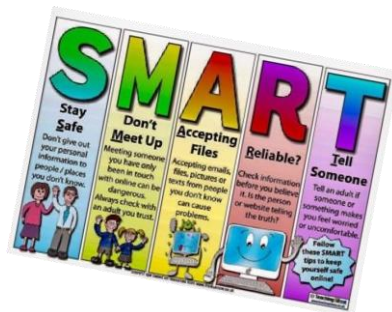

North Baddesley Junior School Mobile Phone Agreement

NBJS Pupil Mobile Phone Agreement

North Baddesley Junior School recognises that on some occasions it may be helpful for a pupil to bring a mobile phone into school, for instance, if they walk to school unaccompanied or they are being collected by a different carer. We believe that pupil use of a mobile phone during the school day can be disruptive and can pose a safeguarding risk and this agreement outlines how pupil phones will be managed within our school. Smartphones and smartwatches are not permitted in school. We are working closely with our feeder school, [Mountbatten](#), to ensure a consistent approach to the devices that are allowed within the school environment.

All pupils bringing a phone into school must have a good reason for doing so and must have returned this agreement to the school office.

- All phones must be handed into the office before registration each morning.
- All phones should be turned off before handing in.
- Phones will be handed to the children by the class teacher at the end of the day. Phones are not to be turned on until they are off the school site.
- The school will help children to learn about staying safe online, but recognises that the primary responsibility for online safety at home lies with parents/carers. The school will seek to work with families to help them to encourage children to adopt safe use of mobile technology.
- Children not following these rules will not be allowed to bring a phone into school. Any phone brought in without permission will be confiscated and only returned to a parent or carer.
- Children must not take photographs or videos of people on school grounds and are never to take them on the way to or from school. This is because some children are not allowed to have their picture taken.
- The school cannot accept responsibility for damage or loss of a mobile phone brought into school.
- The school has the right to confiscate or search a mobile phone. In the unlikely event of needing to do this, we will endeavor to contact a parent or carer. As part of this agreement, your child should agree to unlock the phone if required by a member of staff.
