

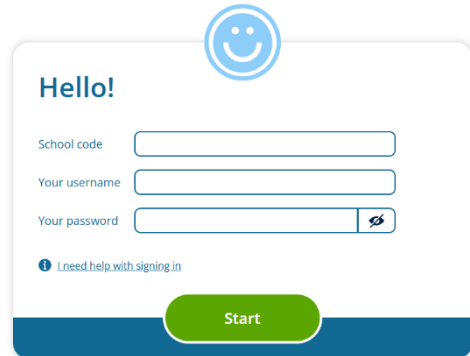
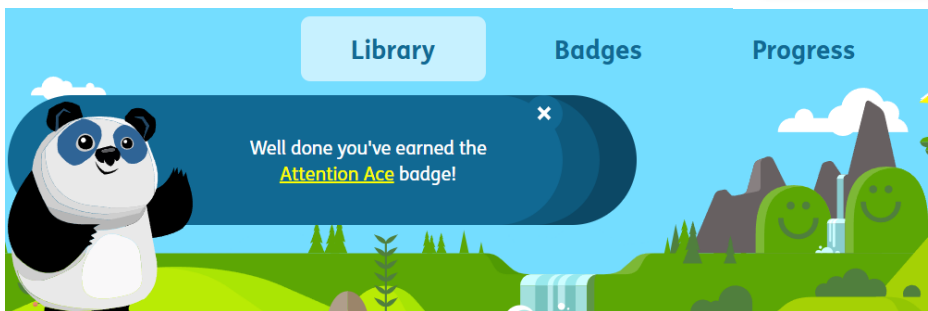
Oxford Reading Buddy is an online reading platform that helps children develop confidence, fluency and comprehension through a wide range of engaging digital books. Each child is matched with books at the right reading level for them, ensuring the correct balance of support and challenge as they progress. After reading, children complete short quizzes and comprehension activities that help them demonstrate their understanding and deepen their thinking about the text. By using Oxford Reading Buddy regularly at home, families can support reading practice, build positive reading habits and celebrate progress together.

Getting Started with Oxford Reading Buddy

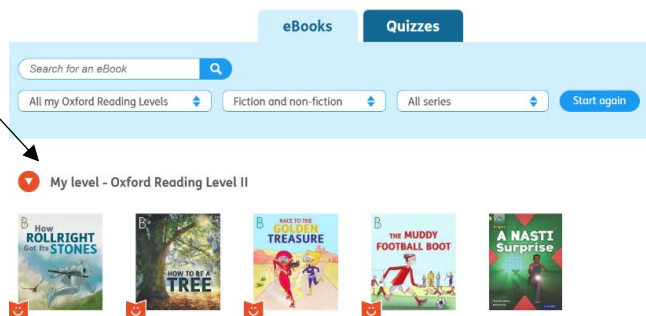
1. Log in using your child's username and password.



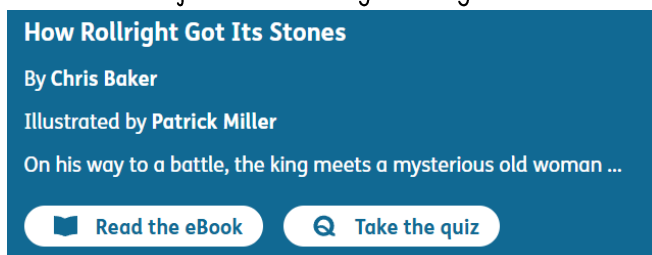
2. Go to the Library section on the home page.

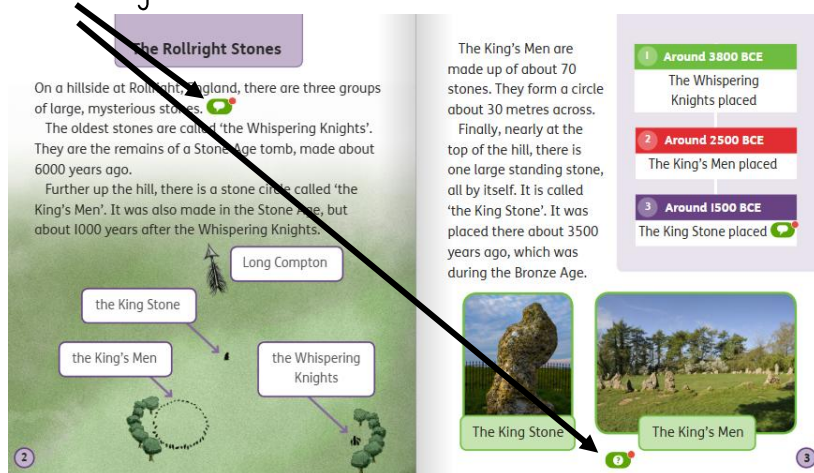
3. Your child will be allocated a reading band by their class teacher, this will be displayed in the ebook section:



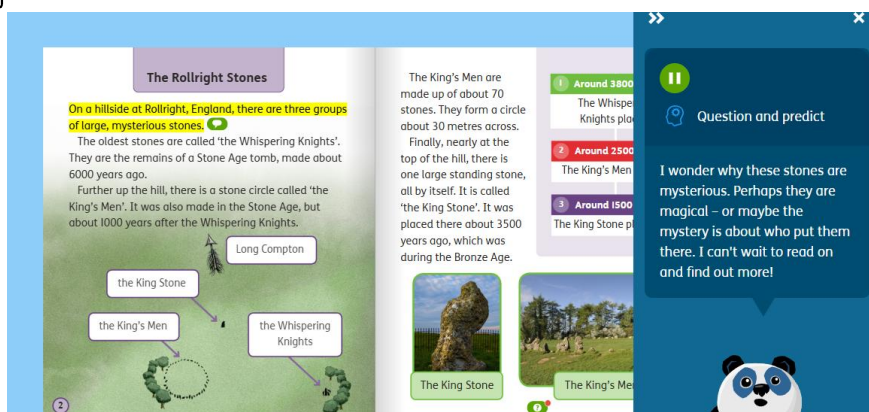
4. Select a book from this list by clicking on it and clicking read the ebook.



5. Encourage your child to read the text as independently as possible and complete the questions as they work through the book:

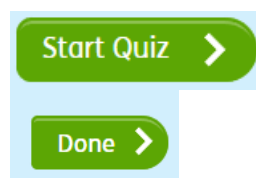


The text will remain visible to help them respond to the questions. Encourage them to refer back and look at the text to find evidence for their answers.



6. When they have completed the book, press start quiz

7. Select done when they have completed the quiz



How parents can help:

Listen to your child read regularly.

Talk about characters, events and new vocabulary.

Ask questions such as:

- What happened in the story?
- Why do you think the character did that?
- What do you think will happen next?
- Which part was your favourite and why?
- Encourage your child to reread tricky sections.
- Praise effort, perseverance and enjoyment of reading.

We recommend that children use Oxford Reading Buddy for 10–15 minutes at least three times each week to support their reading development.
