





<p style="text-align: center;">Nouns</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><i>People, places or things.</i></p>	<p>Do all your proper nouns have a capital letter? <i>Names and places.</i> Mr Hardy North Baddesley</p> <p>Do all your common nouns start with a lower case letter? <i>table, lion, flower.</i></p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Adjectives</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Words used to describe a noun.</i></p>	<p>Have you used a noun in your sentence? <i>A person, place or thing?</i></p> <p>Have you described the noun? The pig. The noisy pig. The noisy pig with the curly tail.</p> <p>Could you use more than one adjective?</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Adverbs</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Words used to describe how you do a verb (an action).</i></p>	<p>Have you used a verb? <i>An action/doing word?</i></p> <p>Have you told you reader how the verb is being done? The horse galloped through the field.</p> <p>The horse energetically galloped through the field.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Prepositions</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Prepositions tell you about the location of a noun.</i></p>	<p>Have you showed the location of your noun? <i>Where is it position?</i></p> <p>Crouching <u>behind</u> the tree, the rabbit hid from the fox.</p> <p><u>On top of</u> the box sat a bow.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Modal verbs</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Words to show possibility or certainty.</i></p>	<p>Have you used modal verbs in your writing to show possibility? <i>Included within instruction or persuasion writing.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Will will not won't Could could not couldn't</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Tense: past, present or future</p>	<p>Have you used the same tense throughout your writing? Have you shown correct verb forms?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">To run -> ran -> will run To hope -> hoped -> hope</p>
