We will continue to teach the children about road safety in assemblies and lessons to ensure that they are crossing roads safely. This week I have had a meeting with the police and discussions with county about how we can improve this issue as it is causing a lot of worry and upset. As you may have seen there has been a greater presence from our traffic warden and our local PCSO and police officer – they have issued fines both on the spot and some are in the post. Please work with us and not against us to ensure that our children and community are safe. 

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
