Eco Committee



This month, Mrs Murphy and our Eco Committee met to discuss upcoming environmental events and share their ideas on projects they would like to participate in. Each classroom now has a designated Eco area for their Green League awards and recycling bins. This month over 80 batteries and over 700 old pens were collected and saved from going into landfill. The children are now researching if refillable marker pens might be better for the environment.



Green League awards this month went to 4H (Daniel) and 5W (Rosanna and Maddison) for their proactive efforts in supporting our Eco projects including last terms bake sale. They were awarded a living spider plant to be named and cared for by the class! Sown last month, the competition sunflowers were planted out in the school garden. The current tallest flower is 30cm tall and was planted by Ivy in 6C. Last year's winner, Ruby in 4C, sunflower is not far behind at 28cm.
