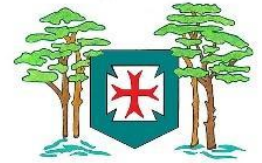




Morning Maths at NBJs



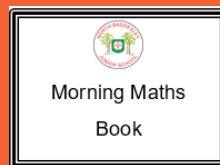
The aim of Morning Maths is to give the children opportunities to recall and reinforce key number facts and skills.

Daily Maths 20 minute activity which is ready on the board when children enter the classroom.

Children to have access to key resources to support them if required.

Presentation expectations that same as in Maths book. One digit per square.

Question focus dictated by assessment for learning from lessons as well as continually revisiting key year group foci.



Sometimes there may be a range of questions on a topic so children can self-select starting points.

Self-marked by children to allow immediate feedback. Children to make in black editing pen and make any necessary corrections.

Ensure there are questions that all can access with success. Morning Maths should not be a barrier for children when coming to school.

For some children, there may need to be a tailored Morning Maths programme. If children are working out of the year group expectations, adaptations will need to be made.
