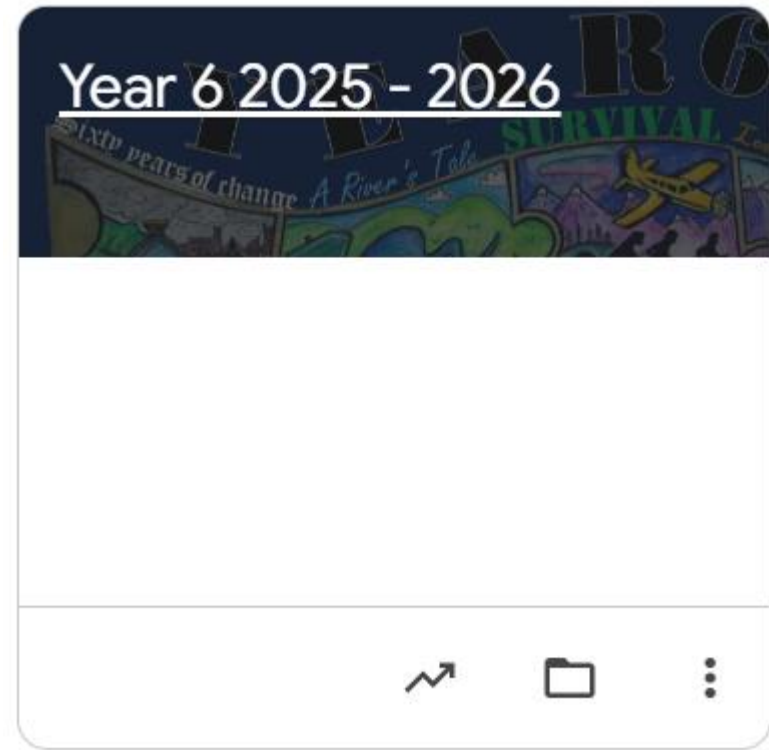

# Shoes

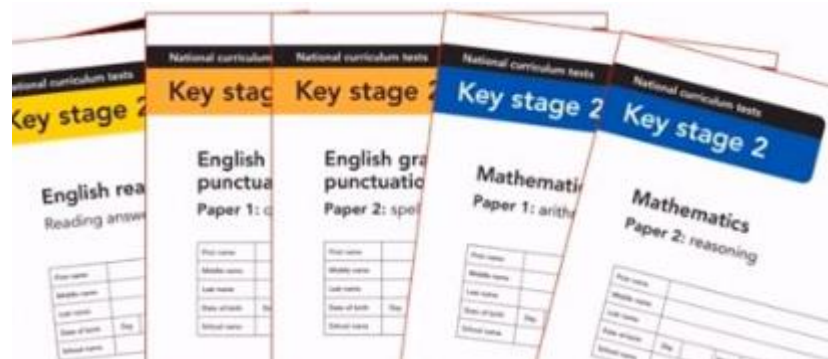
## 5 Footwear

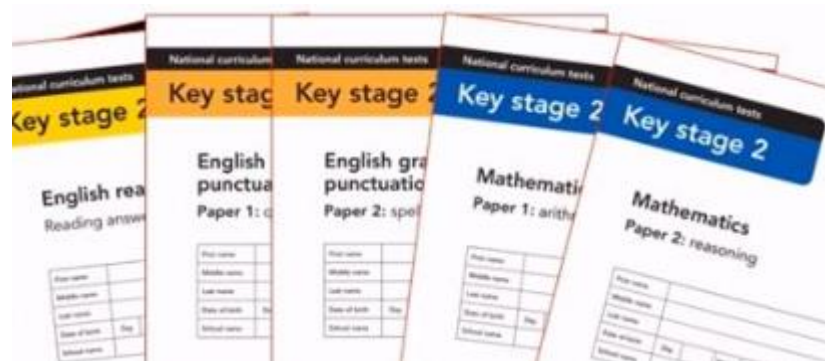

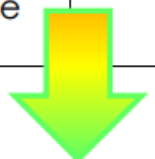
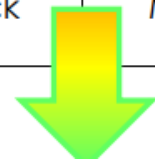
